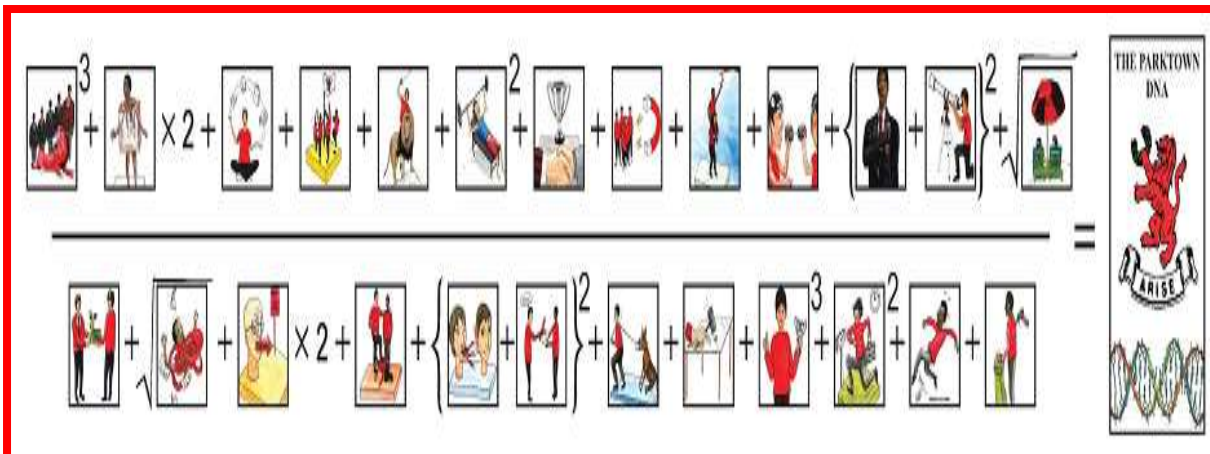
Friday 3rd February

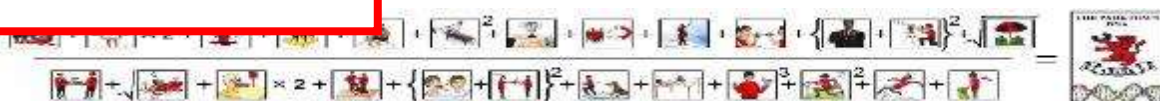
