RUGBY AND HOCKEY

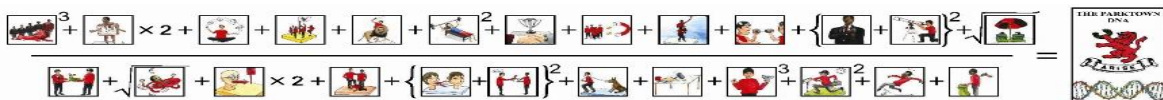

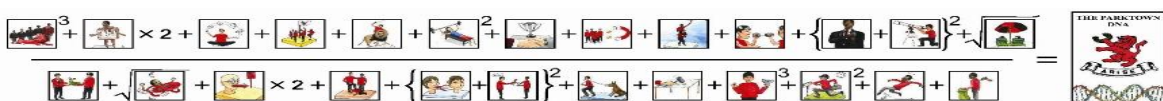

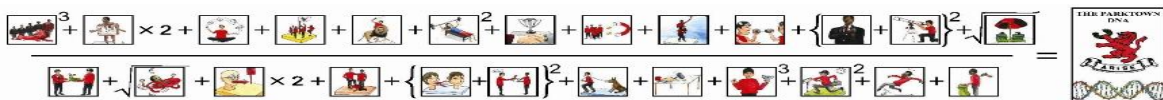
