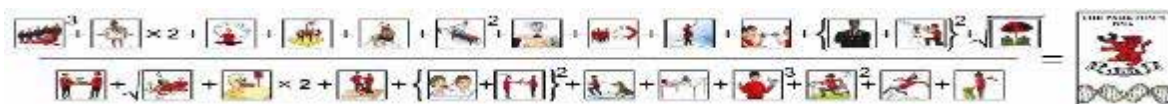
## FOOTBALL

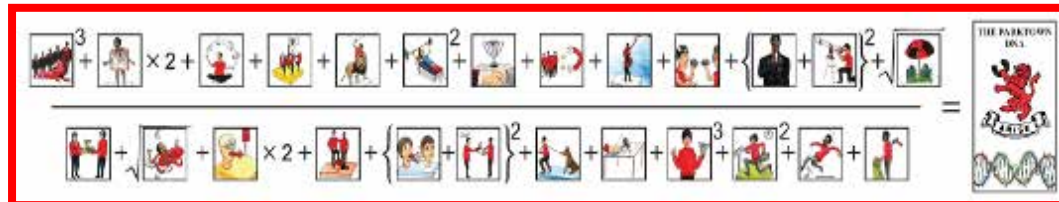
**ENTER RACE**

The Parktown DNA encapsulates our values: Those aspects that we want to live up to in the numerator and those anti-values we want to avoid and eradicate in the denominator:



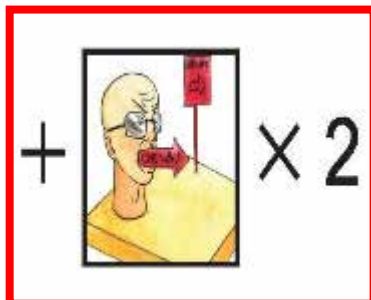
**FEATURED ANTI-VALUE: 'Rude and Abusive Behaviour'.**
