



## PARKTOWN BOYS' HIGH SCHOOL

Congratulations on choosing Parktown Boys' High School as the school for your son. Please note the following practical arrangements regarding the first week of school.

### **Grade 8 Orientation (16-18<sup>th</sup> January 2018)**

This will be an event and team-building exercise during which we plan to:

- Inform the new Form 1 group of Parktown Boys' High Schools' expectations of them.
- Encourage them to be positive, well-adjusted, self-confident and loyal Parktonians.
- Introduce them to the extra-curricular activities offered at the school.
- Help them to cope emotionally and academically with the change from Primary to High School.

### **Request from the Parktown Boys' High School shop:**

Since the orientation is happening during the first week of the new term, it would be appreciated if you would buy the necessary stationery and school uniform before 5<sup>th</sup> of December 2017. For shop hours, please consult the attached school shop/stationery list.

### **The first few days at school:**

- School reopens on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2018 at 07h45.
- The Forms 1's are to gather on the stands overlooking the main cricket oval at 07h30.
- All Form 1's are to be in full **school tracksuit and takkies with their white sports shirt and sports shorts underneath for both Tuesday 16 and Wednesday 17 January**. No jewellery is allowed and hair must be neatly cut and may not be coloured or hi-lighted.
- No books will be required, as lessons will only commence on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2018.

### **Tuesday 16 January 2018:**

All grade 8 learners should meet outside the hall at 07h30 for their Maths and English assessments. The information for these tests will be handed out at the Parent Welcome Evening and if you are unable to attend this function, it will also be available in the School Shop and Mrs Beard's office (after Thursday 16 November). After the tests have been written the learners will have an orienteering program where they will explore the school grounds followed by sports testing sessions. School will end at 14h30.

### **Wednesday 17 January 2018:**

The Form 1's must be seated on the stands overlooking the main cricket oval by 07h45. A school assembly will follow inside the Memorial Hall, led by the Headmaster, after which the learners in Form 2 to 5 will leave the hall to continue their day elsewhere. The Form 1s' will remain in the hall for orientation. The day will end at 14h30 after sports testing.

**Thursday 18 January 2018:**

**Boys are to wear their full school uniform from today onwards.** The Form 1's will meet in the Memorial Hall at 07h45 to continue their orientation with senior members of staff. After these discussions the learners will be allocated to their various classes and houses.

Once the learners have been on break they will be integrated and attend normal lessons for the remainder of the school day and school will end at 14h45.

**Friday 19 January 2018:**

Normal school day.

**Saturday participation in sports:**

All Form 1 learners are required to participate in Saturday sport – either as competitors or as supporters. If the sport your son has chosen does not have inter-school fixtures on a Saturday, he is required to be at school (dressed in full school uniform and basher) to support home fixtures from 09h00 – 12h15. This is by no means a request and full roll call will be taken at every Saturday fixture.

**School Fees for 2018:**

The school fees for 2018 will be finalised at the end of October. We will forward you this information once it is finalised. The contact person for school fee queries is Mr Jacques Ehlers and his email address is ehlersj@parktownboys.com.

**Communication with the school:**

During the first term of your son's Form 1 year we will communicate with you through the school's fortnightly newsletters, the School Communicator, as well as a Form 1 information letters on a regular basis. Please instruct your son to hand over all communication from the school promptly, to enable us to work together effectively and to keep parents fully informed.
