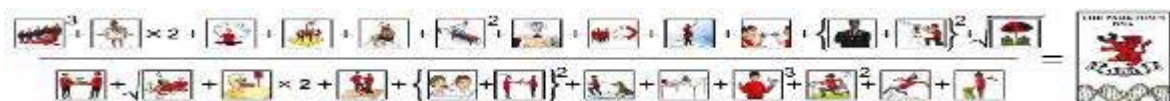

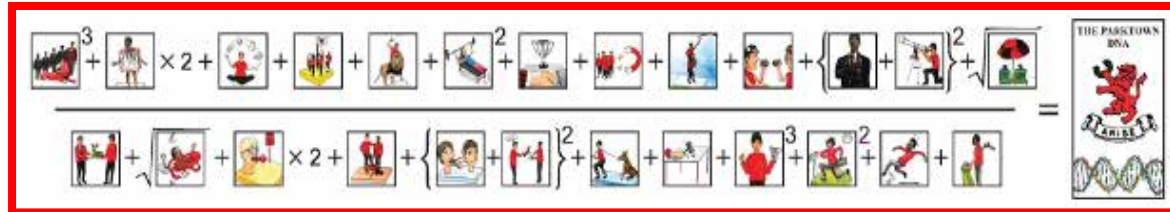

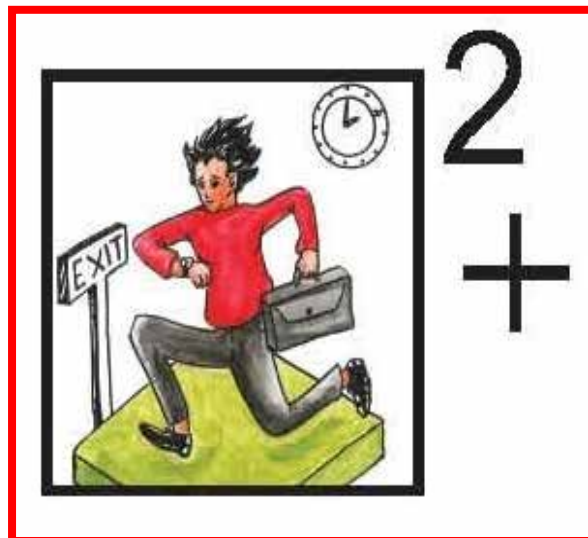


PARKTOWN DNA
